

LOCAL RULES

OUT OF BOUNDS

- Defined by fences posts, white painted lines and white stakes.
- When an out of bounds fence is above a wall, the posts mark the OB and the wall is an integral part of the golf course.

INTERNAL OUT OF BOUNDS

- Right Side at holes 10th and 13th. Both sides at 11th, 17th. Left side at 12th, 16th.

IMMOVEABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

- All paved roads including adjacent cement gutters.
- Internal out of bounds stakes when the out of bounds does not affect the hole being played.
- The plastic border surrounding the greens (only for the ball's lie or the area of his intended swing not for the stance).
- The wooden stakes around the green at hole 13th.
- Close to Putting green: If an immovable obstruction on or within two club length of the putting green and within two club length of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief.

INTERFERENCE BY COURSE CONDITIONS:

Interference occurs when a ball lies in or touches the condition or when the condition interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing. A player may take relief from next course conditions:

- The edge between grass and desert area.
- At any channel created by water.
- Any circular areas around the base of palm trees or any other plant.
- All areas defined by blue stakes.
- Shorter than a club cacti or trees (not weeds), to protect the pant the player must relief.
- Deep rut but not a shallow indentation.

INTEGRAL PART OF THE COURSE:

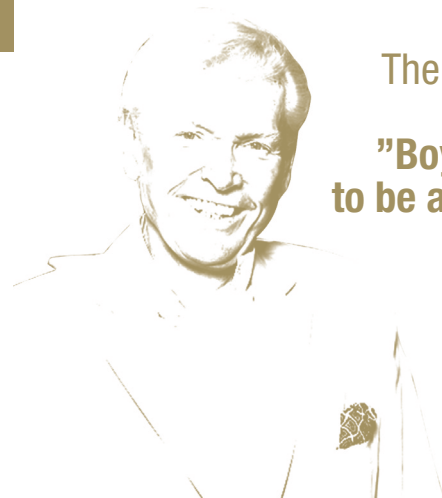
- All walls in the course. Exception: the player may take relief on the upper wall of the channel at the 14th hole.
- Net posts and net.

LATERAL WATER HAZARDS

- There is no opposite margin at the lateral water hazard at the holes 10th, 12th & 13th. The lateral water hazard is defined by the marks and / or the red stakes at the mentioned holes.

DROPPING ZONES

- Holes 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th & 14th. If a player's ball lies in the water hazard the player can play from the dropping zone under penalty of one stroke.

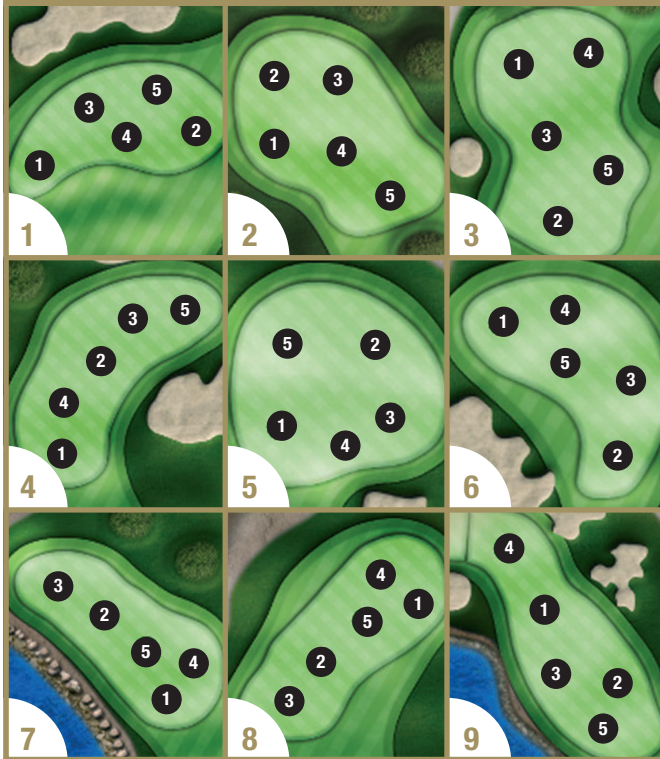
